

A Tea Towel Picnic Bag



Often times in the story of Heidi, grandfather is telling Heidi to pack a lunch bag or a picnic bag so that she will have something to eat while she is up in the mountains playing with Peter.

We made ours with two tea towels.

What You'll Need:

- **Two Cotton Tea Towels**
- **Embroidery Hoop**
- **Embroidery Needle and Thread**
- **Small scissors**
- **1 ½ ft of cording. More if necessary**

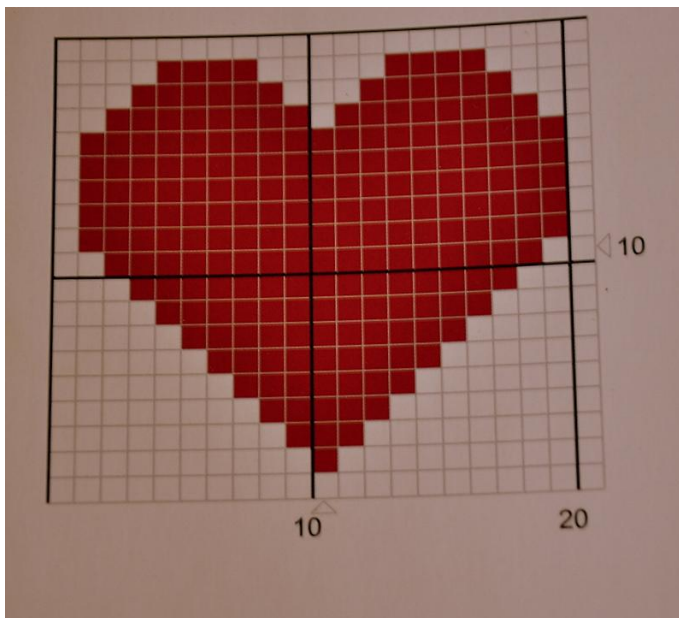
Embroidery Set up:

On one tea towel turn down the 3 ½ inches from the top and bottom.



Center the heart in the middle between these two folded areas.

Embroider the heart on your tea towel using the pattern provided.



Sewing up the bag

1. Place right sides together and cut 3 ½ inches off the bottom.



2. Pin the two sides and bottom together.
3. Sew these three sides with a straight stitch.



4. Sew again with a zigzag stitch.



5. Turn the top of the bag down 3 ½ inches.



6. Sew around the bottom of the turn down leaving a gap so that you can thread your cord through.

7. Attach a safety pin to your cord or ribbon and fish it through.



8. Tie the cord, leaving extra cord so you will be able to cinch the sack.

9. Turn the sack so the right side is facing.



Now it's ready to load with all of your yummy food for your next picnic or adventure. Have Fun!
