

Pirate Flag Placemats



These are so easy and fun to do. For our table and tomorrow's pirate feast let's make pirate placemats.

Supplies:

- **Black Placemats**
- **Wonder under**
- **Iron**
- **Scissors**
- **Pirate Flag Pattern**

We had some black placemats around the house but you can purchase these just about any place or you could make your own out of any black fabric by just hemming the edges.

Print out the pirate flag of your choice and cut out the pattern. These are true pirate flags which flew on some of the ships of the fiercest pirates.

On the shiny side of the wonder under trace your pattern.

Cut out the pattern.

Heat your iron.

As your iron is heating, place your flag pieces on the placemat exactly where you would like them.

Once the iron is heated, take a tea towel and gently place it over the pattern pieces and hold the iron there for a few seconds. Keep moving the iron around the placemat. More of a pick-up and place motion as opposed to a smoothing ironing motion.

Once the pieces are starting to stick, remove the towel and go over the pattern pieces directly.

Once the pieces are sticking, move your placemat aside to cool off.

Repeat this process with your other placemats.
