

Ribbon Wrapped Headbands



When I was a little girl I would always braid my hair to make believe I was Heidi. For my daughters, they would always request that we make ribbon wrapped headbands. We made so many of these when they were small for their "Heidi Days." I couldn't leave these out of our Heidi book adventure.

Items Needed:



- **1 blank headband**
- **2 yards of fabric ribbon**
- **Hot glue gun**
- **Scissors**

Putting it together

1. Cut 2 two inch pieces of ribbon.



2. Glue and wrap the 2 inch pieces around each end of the headband.



3. Starting at the one end of the headband glue the end of your ribbon and start wrapping on the diagonal. Every now and then place some glue on the underneath side and at the top of the headband make sure to glue on every other wrap to ensure the ribbon will hold and not come undone.



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
