

Slingshot Stand

We soon learned that to shoot our water balloon slingshot we would need three people. We didn't always have three people so we invented this slingshot stand which works really well.

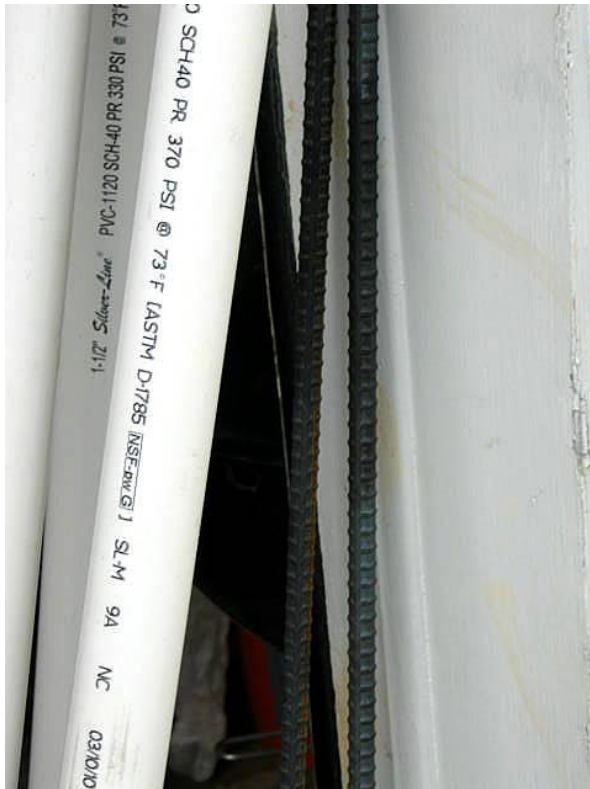
One word of warning though: When you are launching your water balloon, step to the side after you've launched to avoid the back swing from the slingshot.

Supplies: For One Stand

Two PVC pipes 5 feet long by 1 ¼ inches in diameter

Two 5 ft long pieces of rebar

Two hooks and nuts



Mark on both pieces of rebar, in the same spot, where you want to drill your holes for the hook placement.



Drill the holes in both pvc poles.



Place in the hooks and nuts.



Now place one side of the slingshot on the hook and the other side on the other hook.

Now it's time to set the poles. Hammer in the rebar poles about 5 feet apart. Make sure you test this and eye ball it for your yard and slingshot.



Once you've hammered both pieces of rebar into the ground, place the pvc pipe over it.





Now you are ready to launch some water balloons. We made two launching stands and set up and water balloon, water fight court. Enjoy!
